Only **ONE Adult** visitor will be allowed entry into the facility per visit. Children will not be allowed to remain in the vehicle during visiting times. Visiting times will change **WEEKLY**.

Masks must be worn when entering/exiting the facility.

Social distancing will be mandatory. Visitors must follow the areas marked with cones/tape when entering/exiting the facility.

Visitors should arrive early enough to be safely processed into the facility.

Visits will last no longer than 45 minutes.

When visiting an inmate housed in Work Release, all visitors must report to Control 1 to be processed.

When visiting an inmate housed in the Annex, all visitors must report to the Officer posted in the Annex driveway to be processed.

If a visitor is currently experiencing signs/symptoms of COVID-19 or has been in contact with someone that has tested positive within the past seven days, they will not be allowed entry into the facility.

An Officer will be assigned to direct all visitors to designated parking areas in the parking lot.

Sneakers are recommended to pass the metal detector. Visitors should not wear jewelry and should only bring their keys with them.

Restrooms will be unavailable during visiting hours.
